Human factors research, however, suggests that drivers have difficulty in accurately perceiving time to arrival and that other variables, such as the distance to an oncoming vehicle, may be more salient.

Most of the research in gap acceptance has been conducted by observing the gaps real drivers select in natural traffic. These studies have typically focused on estimating the “critical gap” – the minimal gap size acceptable to a population of drivers (Gattis & Low, 1999; Daganzo, 1981; Mahmassani & Sheffi, 1981).

TRAFFIC GENERATION FOR STUDIES OF GAP ACCEPTANCE

A tendency to reject physically adequate gaps can lead to needless delay, while acceptance of an inadequate gap can lead to a conflict or a collision with an opposing vehicle.

Rethinking the Word Gap

Results from this gap acceptance study show that left-turn and crossing match very closely to Green Book recommendations, within 0.2 seconds. The critical gap acceptance that was measured for right-turn vehicles around the City of Laramie was between 0.6 and 0.8 seconds longer than Green Book recommendations.
