Originally developed in 1995 by Enfotec, a subsidiary of Fednav, and recently completely revamped, IceNav is a dual-display computer system that allows vessels to receive, display, manipulate and share ice information products such as ice charts, weather forecasts and satellite imagery in a user-friendly interface.

If the ship is stopped by heavy concentration of ice the rudder should be put amidships and the engines should be kept turning slowly ahead. This will wash away the ice that is accumulated astern and will help the vessel to fall back. In a close pack during ice navigation, avoid sharp alterations of course and keep the speed enough for steerage way.
